**SUDDEN DEATH OF
CANON HANINGTON**

Stricken While Driving in His Carriage—Prominent Anglican Clergyman—His Career

A telephone message to the city last evening gave the sad news that Canon Hanington, rector of Lower Norton, had died with dramatic suddenness about 8 o'clock. He had spent the afternoon in making a round of calls and was driving towards the bridge on his return to the Norton rectory when the Bloomfield station master saw him drop from the carriage.

Only a minute or two previously Mr. and Mrs. H. H. Scovil, who were taking a run in their automobile, talked with him and on seeing something was wrong hastened to where he lay. Mrs. Scovil, formerly Miss George Wilson, a nurse, felt his pulse but found that life had passed away. He was taken at once to the home of Frank Hayes, a few yards away, and the coroner summoned. It is supposed death was caused by heart failure. Canon Hanington's health has been somewhat precarious for some time, he having never entirely recovered from an accident in which he was thrown from his carriage a few years ago.

The late Canon Hanington was about fifty-eight years of age, the eldest son of the late William J. M. Hanington, Esq. He had only held the living of Johnston, Queens county, before he was appointed to Norton about twenty years ago. He was a student of U. N. B. and took his degree there, taking his divinity course at Kings. While he was one of the most scholarly men in the diocese of Fredericton, his diffidence had always kept him modestly in the background. Yet he was a valuable member of many of the diocesan committees and his advice was always well received for its moderation by his fellow clergymen. He

78 BODIES TAKEN FROM VIRGINIA COAL MINE

Hinton, West Va., March 5—Seventy-eight bodies have been recovered up to tonight from the workings of the Layland mines, where an explosion Tuesday entombed more than 170, of whom only ten escaped alive.

Various estimates of the number of victims agree that the total will reach 150.

EMPRESS-STORSTAD CASE CONCLUDED

Montreal, March 5—The argument in the Empress-Storstad case was brought to a conclusion this afternoon, after having occupied the attention of the court for two weeks.

Mr. Geoffrion, K.C., counsel for the C. P. R., concluded his address, in the course of which he dealt principally with the contradictory testimony as to the movements of two vessels immediately prior to the collision. He submitted that Captain Kendall's testimony was amply corroborated by that of the Storstad witnesses themselves, and particularly by the entries made in the engine log of the defendant's vessel.

Judgment was reserved.

CANADA'S FINANCES

Ottawa, March 5—For the month of February the dominion's revenue shows an increase of \$22,294, as compared with February of last year. This is the first increase in revenue reported for a year or so. The increase is, in the main, made up of \$148,854 in customs revenue and \$881,520 from excise and \$146,888 from railway receipts.

The increased customs and excise receipts reflect the result both of the increased tariff and excise duties, and of the rush of importers and manufacturers to beat out the expected increased taxation, announced by the finance minister in the middle of the month.

Expenditure of the month shows a considerable drop, as compared with February of last year. Current expenditure decreased by \$1,488,481 and capital expenditure by \$55,782.

The net public debt increased during February by \$8,518,892 and is now, for the first time, over \$400,000,000 mark. At the end of the month it was \$401,801,909, as compared with \$317,149,801 at the end of February last year, an increase of \$84,652,108 during the twelve months.

Temporary loans made by the government now total \$88,666,066, as compared with \$18,006,886 on February 28, 1914.
