DR. MELVIN IS STRONGLY FOR VACCINATION

St. John Health Officer Tells Plainly Why School Children and Adults, As Well, Should be Vaccinated. Smallpox is a disease which is greatly feared in every community, and the importance of the process of vaccination is being realized more and more every day.

As I understand it," said the doctor, "the law at the present time gives school trustees the power to demand vaccination, and in this way it has been rigidly enforced in St. John, but, in order to make it effective, it should be strictly enforced all over New Brunswick."

As school children should be vaccinated, if this were carried out for a few years, it would have the result that in a short time the whole population of the province would be vaccinated, and that, therefore, smallpox would be virtually unknown, except when imported. The condition of affairs has been attained in most of western Europe, and in very many of the cities of the United States, in consequence of compulsory vaccination, and smallpox has in these places that I have mentioned, become almost unknown.
