BIBLE CONFERENCE ON AT WESTFIELD

MAJORITY CLEAN, BUT SOME FILTHY

Food Inspector Reports on Condition of Shops in St. John

As the new inspector of food in the city, under the direction of the board of health, Mrs. Edmund Flewelling, has made a marvellous record of accomplishment. In the first six weeks after her appointment was confirmed she visited every one of the 500 and more of the city's grocery stores, restaurants, ice cream parlors, bakeries and all other places where food is sold. She made a complete inspection of all the premises of each place and reported to the board of health regarding the conditions of each, making recommendations to the board and suggesting to the proprietors some of the places which she visited divers ways in which they could improve the condition of their premises. Mrs. Flewelling devotes her afternoon to this work and having one completed her survey she is now making the second or third visit to some of the places which were more flagrant in need of improvement. She reports that in some cases comparisons are the very reverse of edifying as in contrasting the present condition of some stores with their state on her first visit, the improvement is so marked as to be a revelation of what it is possible to achieve when energies are directed in the right way.

In her initial survey, Mrs. Flewelling found the majority of stores and restaurants in a clean and orderly state, although some were not so good and could be improved in certain particulars. About thirty-five ranged in her list from "dirty" to "very dirty" and to "unbelievably filthy." There were three or four that came in the lowest class. It appeared that they had not had any attempt at cleaning for years. The floors were thick with dirt and cobwebs hung in festoons from the walls and ceilings. It was one of the dirtiest of these which on Mrs. Flewelling's second visit showed such a marked improvement that it was almost into the perfect class. Cans in bean barrels, milk repoting in a pail and the salt pork barrel and ragged cheese are some of the appalling things which have greeted Mrs. Flewelling on her first round. On the whole there has been a ready willingness on the part of the proprietors to carry out any suggestion to improve their premises, as to the covering of food to prevent dust and flies from reaching it. Resentment has occasionally been offered to Mrs. Flewelling's suggestions. Some of the dealers who have been in the business of selling food for twenty years or more imagine that they know more about how food should be kept than does Mrs. Flewelling. They have done things in such a way for years and surely what custom has established must be right, they appear to think, according to the inspector. Some of the store keepers, Mrs. Flewelling reports, have shown a sincerity of instinct with the ostrich. They have imagined that if the front of the shop was clean it did not much matter if the back was as filthy as a pig sty. It has not been only some of the little shops that have been most severely criticized by Mrs. Flewelling. Some of the smaller shops cared for by women, while they have been very humble and unpretentious, have been scrupulously neat and clean. Penetrating to the kitchens and outside premises of restaurants Mrs. Flewelling has found as a rule that things there were in good order. Her work has had its funny side also. As the result of Mrs. Flewelling's very complete reports and of her energetic work, the board of health now has full knowledge of the conditions under which food is kept in the city stores and eating places. Through her it is carrying out a vigorous educational campaign to give the people knowledge of the importance of handling food in a clean and sanitary way. It is a campaign in which eternal vigilance has of necessity to be the motto and in which the inspector has to repeat again and again her recommendations. To the public, the board of health is looking to add it for it is the public which can help most by refusing to deal at dirty stores and by telling the store-keepers that it is because of the dirt that custom is being removed. Even to the casual observer passing along the streets of the city today, the screened doors and the covered food displayed for the first time in several stores show plainly the results of Mrs. Flewelling's visits.

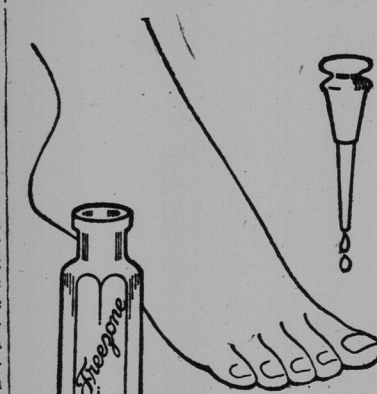

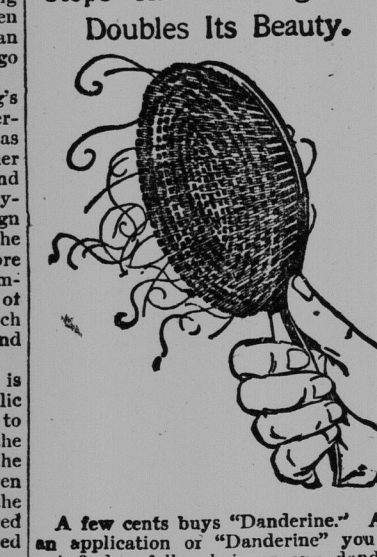

CANADA'S DEBT. HAS AN APPARENT DECREASE IN JULY

Ottawa, Aug. 9.—An apparent decrease of no less than \$65,022,116 in the debt of the dominion which at the end of July stood at \$2,300,119,090 is shown in the financial statement for the month of July, issued today by the department of finance. The figures are, however, more apparent than real, this exceptionally good showing being due in a large measure to transference from the consolidated funds to "investments" of forty million dollars covering loans to soldier settlers by the Land Settlement Board. Deduction of the \$40,000,000 still leaves the debt smaller than it was at the end of June by \$25,000,000, but this again is in a measure due to a change in the government's interest-paying period which was largely responsible for a drop in expenditures for July to \$22,780,304 as compared with \$40,084,840 during July, 1919. Expenditures for the four months' period to July 31 were \$104,939,936 on consolidated fund as against \$76,515,862 in 1919. Expenditures on the capital account side of the ledger make a splendid showing and the disappearance of the item of "war expenditure" which has contributed more than anything else to the growth of the public debt. The figures demonstrating this statement shows a total war expenditure for the first four months of the fiscal year 1919 as \$117,276,824 as against only \$2,078,074 for the same period this year.

FIVE TRAGEDIES OVER WEEK-END IN MONTREAL

The victims were: Victor Richard, aged twelve, drowned in the Riviere des Prairies, while Florent Depocas, aged twenty-two, was drowned when he was seized with cramps in the water; Ovide Lemoule, aged fifty-four, of Chambly Canton, struck by an automobile; Alphonse Babcock, aged fifty, of Huntingdon, struck by an automobile at Valleyfield; Arthur Dussault, aged thirty-six, overcome by the heat.
