

Live Stock Notes for January.

When lambs are dropped this month almost constant care will be required for a few days, especially if the weather is very cold. It is often best to wrap a chilled lamb in a woolen blanket, and even to remove it to the house for artificial warmth by the fire, but to stimulate it with a little hot ginger tea. A few extra early lambs bring more in the spring market than several from the number of late ones.

Milk Cows.

Do not be in two much hurry to dry out the milk cows. If well fed and in comfortable quarters they may be kept in milk to within two months of calving. It does them less injury than trying to stop the flow of milk when it is abundant. Before drying off cease the supply of grain and roots or other succulent food, and give good hay only. Roots may be given for one or two weeks before the calf is expected, but do not resume the grain until the calf is a week old, and then begin with small amounts and increase gradually. Some cows are as naturally dry milkers will give milk the year round without injury, but if they can dry two months it is usually better for them and better for the calf. To cease milking while the cow is giving four or five quarts of milk per day causes great and often permanent injury to the animal than is occasioned by the drain of keeping up the milk supply. A cow that is milked well up to the time of calving will usually have a longer period in which she will have less trouble in dropping it, and if it is desired to raise the calf good feed will make it grow very well afterwards.

Household Hints.

A Scotch haggis is made of the heart, lungs, and liver of a sheep, with salt, onion, oatmeal, salt, and pepper, all boiled in a sheep's stomach. Turkey and celery make a delicious salad, prepared by mixing them with a dressing of oil and vinegar. The salad, especially modern "chicken" salad, which is largely composed of veal.

Norfolk Dumplings.

Take three quarters of a pound of flour, three tablespoonful of milk, warm water one teaspoonful of yeast, and half a teaspoonful of salt. Stir the salt into the flour, make a hole in the middle of it, pour in the water, add the yeast, stir round till all the water is absorbed, and you have a ball of the substance of sponge. Cover it with the remaining flour; let it stand covered, with a clean cloth in warm place for two hours, then work it into a ball of rather stiffer texture. Let it stand till a crust is formed, then put it into a newspaper of boiling water, and boil gently for half an hour. Divide with two forks.
