The Shooting Took Place on Lexington Avenue, New York City, on Monday Night, Sept. 16, 1890.

George Dietel, 61 years old of 49 Avenue B, shot Francis Birk, a former member of the mounting department of the New York City Police.

Birk had been shot in the back, and he fell on his face in the street. The man who had shot him stood still and looked at him a moment, then he put the revolver in his pocket, turned around and walked off.
