

MINUTES

OF THE

BAY OF QUINTE CONFERENCE

OF

THE METHODIST CHURCH,

HELD IN THE TOWN OF PETERBORO', FROM JUNE 2ND TO JUNE 7TH, 1897.

The FOURTH SESSION of the BAY OF QUINTE CONFERENCE was opened in the George Street Methodist Church, in the Town of Peterboro', on Thursday, June 2nd, 1887, at 9 o'clock a.m.

Rev. JOHN S. CLARKE, President of the Conference, presided and conducted the devotional exercises, which continued for one hour.

Rev. A. CARMAN, D.D., General Superintendent, then took the chair.

The Secretary, Rev. JOSEPH YOUNG, read the 46th Psalm and the 3rd chapter of 1st Corinthians. The 661st hymn was sung, and Rev. JOHN S. CLARKE, President, led in prayer.

Rev. A. CARMAN, D.D., General Superintendent, delivered an address of some length upon the work and prosperity of the Church.

The roll was called by the Secretary, and 98 ministers and 57 lay delegates answered to their names.
