BILL.

An Act to provide Funds for defraying the cost of erection of the Lunatic Asylum and other Public Buildings in Upper Canada.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make better provision Preamble. for paying off the principal and interest of the Debentures issued for the purpose of raising funds for the defraying the expense of erecting of the Lunatic Asylum 5 in Upper Canada under the provisions of the Act hereinafter mentioned, and for raising a fund for defraying the cost of erecting other public buildings in that portion of this Province, of general importance to the inhabitants thereof; Be it therefore enacted, &c.

10 That so much of the Act of the Parliament of Upper Rate imposed Canada, passed in the second year of Her Majesty's C. Act of U. Reign and intituled, "An Act to authorize the crection of 2 Vict. c. 11. "an Asylum within this Province for the reception of repealed." " Insane and Lunatic, persons," as authorizes the impos-15 ing of an assessment of one eighth of a penny in the pound for the purposes of the said Act, shall be and is hereby repealed; as are also all rates and assessments made under the authority of the said Act: except in so Exception. far as regards any arrears of such rates and assessments

20 remaining due and unpaid when the said repeal shall take effect.

II. And be it enacted, That instead of the rate men- A new rate tioned in the said Act, there shall be and there is hereby imposed upon all taxable property real or personal in 25 Upper Canada, a yearly rate or tax of six pence in the hundred pounds (and so in proportion on any less sum) on the assessed actual value of such property, or of one penny in the pound on the assessed yearly value thereof, according as the same is assessed by its actual or yearly 30 value, and such rate or tax shall be entered upon the Collectors Rolls, in a separate column, by the Clerk or Officer making out the same, and shall be received, collected and levied by the same Officers, at the same times and in the same manner as other local taxes, rates or as-35 sessments on the same property; and all moneys arising How to be therefrom and received by any Collector snall be paid collected, paid over, &c. over by him to the County Treasurer or City Chamberlain at the same times and under the same provisions and with the same remedy in case of non-payment, as other
