

### III. ADMISSION OF PARTIES TO DEFEND:

25. Proceedings when seat vacant or Member declines to defend.
26. Voters may defend in such cases.
27. Members once declining to defend not to do so afterwards, and not to sit.
28. Petitioner for permission to defend to give Recognizance, &c.—Schedule A. 3.
29. Provision in case of double Returns.

### IV. GENERAL COMMITTEE OF ELECTIONS:

30. Speaker to appoint General Committee of Elections.
31. House may disapprove and new appointment to be made.
32. Disapproval may be general or special.
33. Members not disapproved may be again named.
34. Appointments to be for Session.
35. Vacancies to be reported.
36. General Committee may be dissolved.
37. Vacancies to be supplied.
38. Speaker to fix time and place of meeting.
39. Four Members necessary to proceed.
40. Committee to regulate their own proceedings subject to this Act.
41. Clerk to keep minutes, &c.
42. Upon dissolution or suspension of General Committee, Speaker may adjourn business pending before such Committee.

### V. PANELS:

43. Members temporarily excused from serving.
44. Members temporarily disqualified from serving.
45. List to be made of excused and disqualified Members.
46. List to be corrected.
47. Selection of Chairmen of Election Committees from list.
48. Remainder of list to be divided into three Panels.
49. General Committee to correct Panels.
50. Power to transfer from Panel to Panel in certain cases.
51. Provision for supplying vacancies and increasing Chairmen's Panel.

### VI. APPOINTMENT OF SELECT COMMITTEES:

52. Election Petitions to be referred to General Committee who shall make list thereof.
53. Proceedings on notification of Member's death or declining to defend.
54. When more than one Petition.
55. Select Committees to be chosen in order of list.
56. Cases of Petitions standing over on Prorogation.
57. Publication of time of choosing committees in printed votes.
58. Provision when no one to defend.
59. General Committee may change day of choosing Select Election Committee.
60. Notices of Petitions and Panels to be published in the printed votes.
61. Choosing Select Election Committee for trying Petition.
62. In case of non-agreement General Committee to adjourn.
63. Chairman to be chosen by Chairmen's Panel.
64. Members of Chairmen's Panel to make Regulations.
