MEMORANDUM:

Hon. Mr. Laird.

At your convenience will you kindly look into the question of what division should be made of the funds accruing from the sale of Timber on Reserve #06 A. under Surrender by the Indians - e.g.: - what proportion should be credited to Montreal Lake Band and what to the Lac la Ronge Band.

Attached is a memo of Mr. Jean's which throws considerable light on the subject.

At the present time all moneys are and have been credited to a common fund, A/C 336, but the expenditure from it has almost entirely been for the Montreal Lake Band, and these Indians are now making further demands.

Attached is a copy of the Surrender which appears to have been signed by Montreal Lake Indians only.
