

DATE	SUMMARY OF EVENTS
Friday March 1	Normal flying routine carried out.  Weather: Cloudy and mild, clearing later in day.
Saturday March 2	Normal routine carried out.  Weather: Cloudy and mild
Sunday March 3	Nil  <del>Weather: Cloudy and mild with rain.</del>
Monday March 4	No flying because aerodrome unserviceable from rain and mild weather.  Weather: Cloudy and mild with rain.
Tuesday March 5	Flying Fleet aircraft only carried out in morning. No flying in afternoon, because aerodrome unserviceable. F/Os Drury and Bell reported from Camp Borden to instruct in this school.  Weather: Cloudy and cool
Wednesday, March 6	No flying because of unserviceable aerodrome. F/Os Ingram and Fraser reported to instruct in this school.  Weather: Cloudy and mild with occasional snow.
Thursday March 7	Three Avro 'Ansons' received this date. Normal flying routine carried out.  Weather: Overcast, mild.
Friday March 8	Normal flying routine carried out.  Weather: Cool, overcast. Cleared at noon
Saturday March 9	Normal flying routine in the morning. Aerodrome serviceable but occasional hole found where shell ice has formed.  Weather: Cool, overcast.
Sunday March 10	Nil  Weather: Cool, clear, bright and windy.
Monday March 11	Normal work carried out. Aerodrome in very good shape. Night flying carried out from 1830 hours to 2230 hours.  Weather: Cool, bright day.
Tuesday March 12	Normal routine. Night flying carried out from 1830 hours to 0330 hrs. March 13.  Weather: Bright, clear and cold
Wednesday March 13	Normal work carried out.  Weather: Clear, bright and cool
Thursday March 14	No flying because of weather.  Weather: rain and snow.
Friday March 15	Normal routine carried out.  Weather: Cool and clear.
