a very much larger amount will be required to be raised for said purpose than is now raised;

And Whereas, at a meeting of the mayors of cities and towns, and wardens of municipalities, called by His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, and held at the City of Fredericton on the 30th day of March, 1916, it was resolved that such amount as may be required as aforesaid for said purpose be raised by assessment upon the several cities, towns and municipalities of the province;

- Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor and Legislative Assembly, as follows:
- 1. There shall be assessed upon the several cities, towns and municipalities of the province in the year 1917, and every year thereafter during the continuance of the present war, such amount as the Provincial Executive of New Brunswick branch of "The Canadian Patriotic Fund" shall deem necessary for the purposes of said corporation in this province, subject to the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council as hereinafter provided.
- 2. The said sum or sums shall be levied and assessed by the same assessors, and collected in the same manner, as other rates and taxes, and the assessors in making up the assessment roll shall place in a column headed "Patriotic Tax" the amount payable by each ratepayer under this Act.
- 3. The Provincial Executive of "The Canadian Patriotic Fund" for New Brunswick shall make an estimate of the amount annually required for the purposes of the said Fund, and apportion the amount to be levied, assessed and collected from each city, town and municipality, according to the valuation of the real and personal property and income
