Ottawa, 29th February, 1908.


Sir,-

As requested in your letter of the 27th instant, the Department has decided to loan you \$1500.00 for the purpose of buying seed grain for the Indians of the Qu'Allelle Agency upon the understanding that it is repaid within one year from date, and I enclose cheque No. 4909 for the amount.

When the seed has been purchased you should forward receipts from the parties from whom the purchases were made. These receipts should show the quantity purchased and the price paid. A list of the names of the Indians who received the seed, giving the quantities supplied each should also accompany the receipts.

The above should appear in the Agency cash book, as well as all transactions arising therefrom.
