I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the ----- day of August, No. 714, inclosing return of timber taken out by and for Messrs Burton & Bro. last season, and in reply to inform you that there are no specifications of measurement of square timber among them.

Inclosed you will receive a statement of the quantities shown for each of the Disenses, 3, 4, 5 and 6, also the quantities taken out by Indians under Permits on the Carleton River Reserve.

The crown dues, as ascertained, amount to \$3206.63, and you will have the goodness to procure and transmit the missing specifications and the balance shown to be due.

There is also a balance of \$4.00 due for ground rent and renewal fees.
