NAHWITTI BAND.

Application 20 appears to be the only land available in all the applications made by this band which is open and available.

Mr Ashdown Green visited this plot in April last and put in a preliminary post.

~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ QUASHNELAH BAND.

This band made applications No 21 to 29 inclusive.

I have made a sketch of the applications recommended for this band, which is attached to this report. The maps available were very imperfect most of the sketch being from memory, but are sufficiently correct to locate the applications.

In their applications No 23 & 24 it is recommended that the village site on Indian Island including several small islands lying in Takush Harbor be granted. This would amount to approximately 15 acres. Marked A on sketch.

Application 25 is recommended as an alternative reserve. It is marked C on the sketch. It lies on the west side of the river draining Long Lake into Wyolees Lagoon. The Indians have houses and gardens on this piece and use it every year and have their gardens fenced. 20 acres recommended. The Indian name is Toksee.

Application 26 called Kalowis is marked D on the sketch. 10 acres recommended on Smokehouse Creek. This plot together with 25 were visited by Mr Ashdown Green and the Agent in April last.

Application 27 Marked E on the sketch. This was wrongfully located at the time of the visit of the Royal Commission.

It lies at the mouth of the Tseetsum-sawlasilah river on the north side of Naysash Inlet about a mile from the bend of the Inlet.

✓ Application 28 NEMAITL recommended 5 acres on Ethal Cove at the mouth of Boswell Inlet, marked F on sketch.
