MARWITTI BAND.

Application 80 appears to be the only land available in all the applications made by this band which is open and available.

Mr Amhdown Green visited this plot is April last and put is a preliminary post.

MERSKEREREXXX QUASHELAH BAND.

This band made applications No 21 to 29 inclusive.

I have made a sketch of the applications recommended for this band, which is attached to this report. The maps available were very imperfect most of the sketch being from memory, but are sufficiently correct to locate the applications.

In their applications No 25 à 24 it is recommended that the village site on Indian Island including several small islands lying in Takush Harbor be granted. This would smount to approximately I5 scree. Marked A on sketch.

Application 35 is recommended as an alternative reserve.

It is marked 0 on the sketch. It lies on the west side of the river draining Long Lake into Wycless Lagoon. The Indians have houses and gardens on this piece and use it every year and have their gardens fenced. 20 acres recommended. The Indian name is Toksee.

Application 26 called Halowis is marked D on the sketch.

10 acres recommended on Smokehouse Greek. This plot together with 25 were visited by Mr Ashdown Green and the Agent in
April last.

Application 27 Marked E on the sketch. This was wrongfully located at the time of the visit of the Royal Commission. It lies at the mouth of the Tweetsum-eswissilah river on the north side of Maysash Inlet about a mile from the bend of the Inlet.

Application 28 REMAITL recommended 5 scree on Mines
