2. When I looked out the window again a few seconds later, the Lodestar had stopped his descent and was continuing his flight over the field towards the south. The piper cub continued to taxi north on runway 14-32. He turned around and took off on runway 14. At 2225 GMT I called the Lodestar and advised him that the Piper Cub was now off runway 14-32 airborne. The Lodestar Pilot checked OK and turned around to make his landing on runway 14 at 2227 GMT.
