WHEREAS it is expedient for the Conve- Preamble. ' nience of the Public, that Alterations should be made in certain Parts of the Great Road from ' Saint John to the Nova Scotia Line :'

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Line of Road Council, and Assembly, That the Road leading from the City and Saint John to from the City of Saint John to Westmorland, be Westmorland by the following Line or Route ; that is to say, From Saint John to the Fork of the Road on the Great Marsh, from thence following the present Road towards Gondola Point as far as Andrew Henigar's, from thence to the Hammond River near Ketchum's, from thence by the most practicable Route to Hampton Ferry, and through Sussex Vale to the Bridge over the Salmon River, near
