

CAP. VIII.

An Act for applying certain Monies therein mentioned for the service of the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-six, and for other purposes.

(Passed the 20th day of March, 1846.)

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY:

We, Her Majesty's dutiful and loyal subjects, the House of Assembly of Her Majesty's Province of Nova Scotia, towards appropriating the Supplies granted to Her Majesty, and for supplying the exigencies of Her Majesty's Government, do humbly beseech that it may be enacted; and

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That, by or out of the Monies which now are, or from time to time shall be or remain in the Public Treasury of this Province, there shall be paid the sum of 200*l.* to the Speaker of the House of Assembly, in full, for his Salary as Speaker for the present year. 200*l.* Speaker of Assembly.

And a further sum of 600*l.* to the Treasurer of the Province, for his Salary, and as Comptroller and Auditor of Public Accounts, and in lieu of Office Rent, Clerks, and all other contingent expenses for the same year. 600*l.* Treasurer.

And a further sum of 200*l.* to the Clerk of the House of Assembly, for his services in the same year. 200*l.* Clerk of Assembly.

And a further sum of 25*l.* to the Clerk of the House of Assembly, to be paid by him to the Chaplains who have attended the House of Assembly during the present Session. 25*l.* Chaplains.

And a further sum of 100*l.* to the Clerk Assistant of the House of Assembly, for his services for the same Session. 100*l.* Asst. Clerk of Assembly.

And a further sum of 50*l.* to George R. Grassie, for his services as Sergeant at Arms to the House of Assembly for the same Session. 50*l.* Sergeant at Arms.

And a further sum of 30*l.* to John Jennings, for his services as Assistant Sergeant at Arms to the House of Assembly for the same Session. 30*l.* Asst. Sergeant at Arms.

And a further sum of 40*l.* to the Messenger of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Commander-in-Chief for the time being, and the Executive and Legislative Councils for the present year. 40*l.* Messenger of Governor.

And a further sum of 30*l.* to John Gibbs, for his services as Messenger to the House of Assembly during the present Session. 30*l.* Messenger of Assembly.

And a further sum of 250*l.* to such person as shall perform the duties of Cashier of the Savings' Bank, and First Clerk of the Treasury, for the present year. 250*l.* Cashier of Savings Bank, &c.

And a further sum of 45*l.* to the Clerk of the Commissioners of the Revenue for his services for the present year. 45*l.* Revenue Clerk.

And a further sum of 200*l.* to the Guager and Weigher for the Collector of Impost and Excise for the District of Halifax, for his services for the present year. 200*l.* Guager and Weigher.

And a further sum of 100*l.* to the Proof Officer at Halifax, for his services in that capacity for the present year, and in lieu of all contingent expenses connected therewith, pursuant to the Report of the Committee on Trade and Manufactures. 100*l.* Proof Officer.

And a further sum to be paid on the certificate of the Commissioners of the Revenue, at the rate of 7*s.* 6*d.* per day to such person or persons as shall be employed during the present year by the Collector of Impost and Excise for the District of Halifax, as Extra Waiter or Waiters for the Port of Halifax; 5*s.* per day to such extra Waiter or Waiters when unemployed, and at the rate of 5*s.* per day to temporary Waiters. Pay of Waiters.

And a further sum of 60*l.* to the Keeper of the Assembly House, and Council Chamber and Law Library for the present year. 60*l.* Keeper of Assembly House.

And a further sum of 600*l.* for the support of the Transient Poor for the present year, to be paid to the Commissioners of the Poor at Halifax. 600*l.* Comrs. of Poor.
