at least one good and sufficient Bell, under the Penalty of Five Shillings for each and every offence: Provided, that no person shall be liable to more than one Penalty in one and the same day—to be recovered, with Costs, in manner herein-before mentioned.

IX. And be it further enacted, That all Prose-commencement cutions under this Act shall be commenced within under this Act. Six days after the committing of the offence.

X. And be it further enacted, That all Moneys Appropriation of arising from Fines under the Provisions of this Act, shall be paid into the Public Treasury of this Island.

XI. And be it further enacted, That an Act Repeals Act of made and passed in the Twenty-first Year of the 21 Geo. 3, cap. Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled An Act to prevent disorderly riding of Horses, and driving of Carts, Trucks and Sleds, or any other Carriage whatsoever, within Charlottetown, shall be, and the same is hereby repealed.

CAP. XV.

An Act relating to the Office of Surrogate and Judge of Probate of Wills, and for granting Letters of Administration.
