



## Proclamation.

*By His Excellency ANTHONY MUS-  
GRAVE, Esquire, Governor and  
Commander-in-Chief in and over  
the Island of Newfoundland and  
its Dependencies, &c.*

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

**W**HEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands PROROGUED until WEDNESDAY the TWELFTH day of DECEMBER instant: and whereas I think fit to PROROGUE the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY the THIRTY FIRST day of JANUARY next ensuing: I do therefore, by this my Proclamation, further PROROGUE the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY the THIRTY FIRST day of January next, as aforesaid, *then to meet for the despatch of business*: of which all Persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Great Seal  
of the Island of Newfoundland, at  
the Government House, at St. John's,  
in the said Island, this Tenth day of  
December, 1866, and in the Thirtieth  
Year of Her Majesty's Reign.
