Candles and Cold Water.

New regulations governing standard otels in Ontario have just been issued by the License Board. One of the most important affects the position of ropes for fire escapes. The principal regulations may be summarized as follows;-Every standard hotel now has to have a candle placed in each bedroom. This is for the purpose of helping the guest who may be in the hotel when a fire breaks out and the lighting system is put out of business. There have been cases where the lights have gone out and in the confusion without a light lives have been lost. Every standard hotel must in future keep a supply of pure cold water for drinking purposes for the guests. Another thing is that storm windows are commends that instead metal weather strips be used as this will keep out cold draughts in winter and dust in summer Storm windows, it is claimed, would pre vent the free opening of windows in case of fire. The situation of ropes used for the purpose of escaping from bedrooms in case of fire has been changed. old rule used to be that they had to be fastened on the sill but the Commercial Travellers' Association has pointed out the danger of this to the board and the rule is now that they must be fastened from the side of the window at least two feet from the sill, thus making it easier for the guests to get out in case of danger. 
