### FIRE CAUSED LOSS OF HALF A MILLION

#### New York Firemen were also Injured in the Conflagration

New York, Jan. 3.—Fire destroyed the big furniture store of Cowper wait & Sons at Third Avenue and 121st street tonight, entailing a loss of half a million dollars or more, and causing the injury of four firemen, none seriously. The blaze which started about six o'clock, quickly developed into the stubbornest and most spectacular fire in Harlem for a long time. It blocked the Third Avenue elevated line for hours, at the time of its heaviest traffic and drew such immense crowds that many police reserves were called out to maintain order. For a time the fire threatened the entire block, and it required three hours of hard work for the firemen to bring it under control. The Cowperwaithe establishment, a big five storey structure was destroyed. The stock was valued at \$200,000 fully insured and the building at as much more. The fire started in the basement, and an explosion of varnish followed immediately. The two first firemen on the scene were overcome by smoke in the basement, and were dragged out with difficulty by other firemen. One of them was badly burned and was removed to a hospital. About two hundred feet from the building is the Harlem police court and the prison. The fifty-eight prisoners set up cries of fear and were taken from their cells and were paraded in the Third Avenue wall of the burning building fell across the elevated railroad structure and the firemen were fighting the flames from that vantage place and were forced to leap to the ground. Capt. Lummay was slightly injured in falling. Another wall fell across 121st St. and buried several small buildings. Several firemen barely escaped being buried in the ruins.

### Dr. Herdman Speaks Well of Galicians

Rev. Dr. Herdman, superintendent of missions, is very much interested in the progress that is being made by the Galicians in Alberta. He speaks with enthusiasm of the work that is being done by the church among the Galician settlements. He also speaks very highly of the efforts that the government are making to place schools among the Galicians and comments on the eagerness with which schools are received. To the Albertan last night he made this statement: "The Home Mission department of the Presbyterian Church took up some work among the Galicians around Edmonton last spring. Three Ruthenian missionaries were sent in, and now two others are expected around Vegreville and Whitford. "There is also a hospital at Vegreville, built and supported by the W.H.M.S. and the H.M.C. in Toronto, chiefly for taking care of the sick in the large Galician colony of that neighborhood. "It is also a good thing to know that the Government of Alberta have established 21 public schools among the Galician settlements, all of them gladly paying taxes and desiring more schools to be initiated."

This means that at least 3,600 children of school age have been added to the population of the province, and may be regarded as an undeniable evidence of the development of our rural districts. The increase does not include towns or villages.

Paris, Jan. 3.—There was a remarkable scene tonight at the notorious Moulin Rouge when the Marquise De Morny, a daughter of the famous Duke De Morny and a niece of Napoleon III., made her debut in an act called "A Dream of Egypt," written by herself in collaboration with Mme. Gauthier-Villars, the author of "Claudine" and other decadent novels. The marquise, who is the divorced wife of the Marquis De Bellefleur, has already achieved an undeniable reputation and her heralded appearance on the stage brought out a storm of criticism. To this the marquise replied in a letter this afternoon denying the charge of indecency and insisting that she meant to give an artistic reproduction of the manners of ancient Egypt. In defending her appearance upon the stage the marquise says: "This does not constitute a disgrace to the French aristocracy, and a distinguished scion of this aristocracy, the Prince De Broglie, has been earning his living for some time past by conducting an orchestra in New York."



at, wound or kill any big game animal, or for hearing animal whether protected by this act or not, without first obtaining a license in that behalf; every such license shall be signed by the minister and shall be in force for the calendar year in which the same is issued and the game laws in force in the province shall be subject to the provisions of the act at the time the said license is granted. The fee to be paid therefor shall be \$25 for a general license or \$15 for a bird license, or \$10 for a license to trap for bearing animals. Such license shall not be valid unless the signature of the person to whom it is issued is endorsed thereon.

For \$2.00 however a bona fide guest, being a non-resident, may secure a license entitling to hunt five consecutive days.

Any violation of any of the provisions of this act, except as herein provided, shall be an offence punishable on summary conviction with a fine or taking of peace as respects killing or taking of buffalo, with a fine not less than \$50 and not more than \$100, and as respects any other violation of this act with a fine not exceeding \$100 with costs in either case, half of which fine shall be paid to the complainant and the other half into the general revenue of the province; but if the complainant refuses to accept same the whole of the fine shall be paid into the general revenue of the province. On payment of such fine and costs forfeited with after conviction the offender shall be imprisoned in the gaol for a period not exceeding three months.
