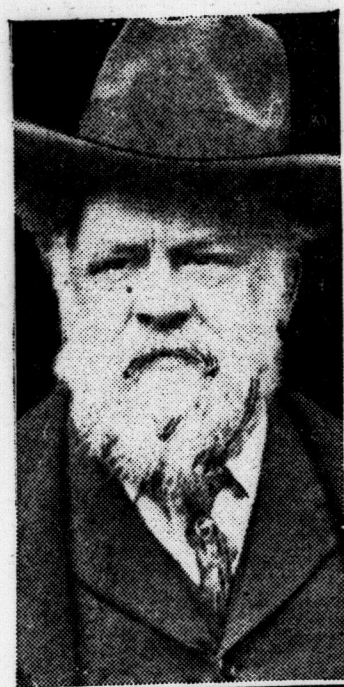
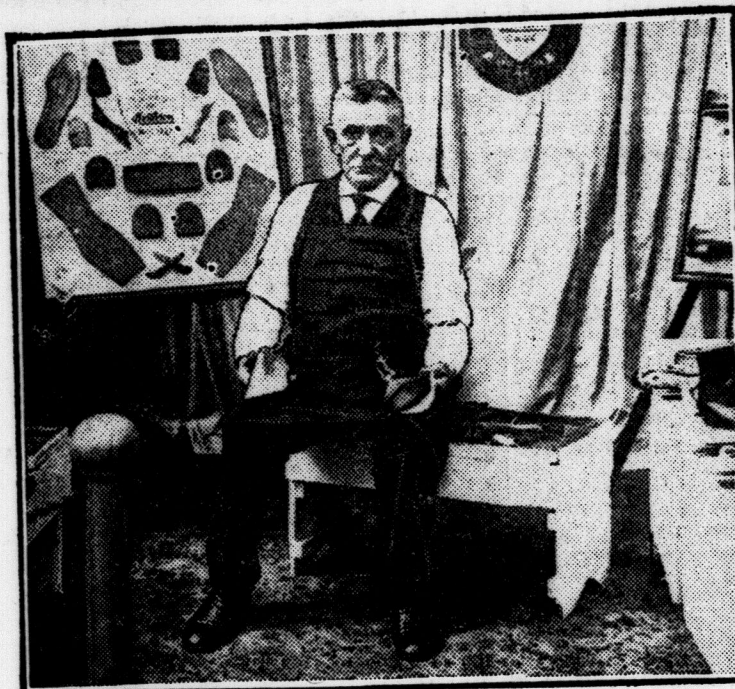




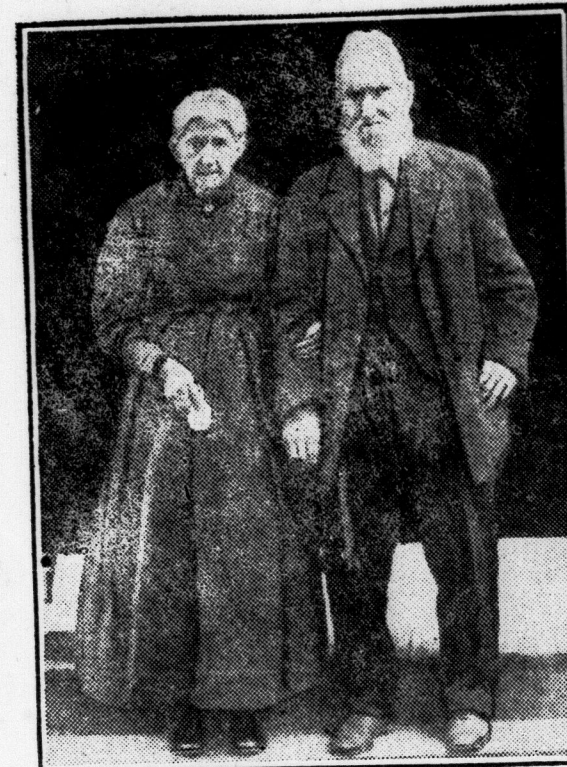
John Little took this picture of one of the bears in the Springbank zoo.



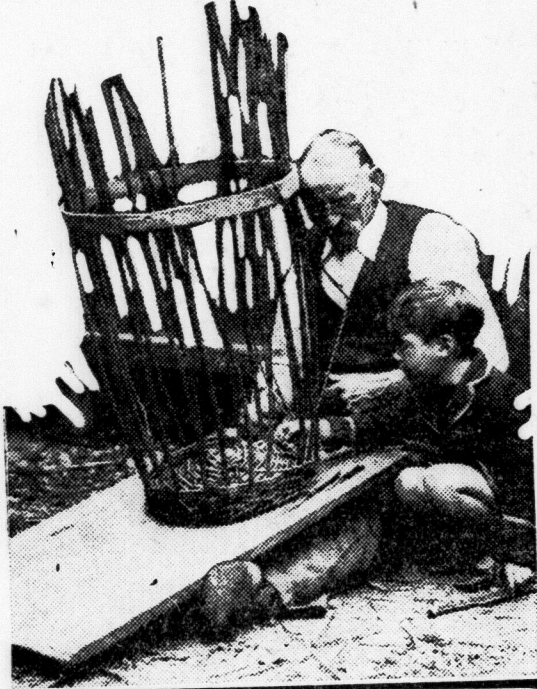
Arthur Shirley, noted English actor and dramatist, who died recently.

Basket-making concern at North Walsham, Norfolk, founded in 1108. One of the present partners is shown giving his grandson a lesson in the craft.



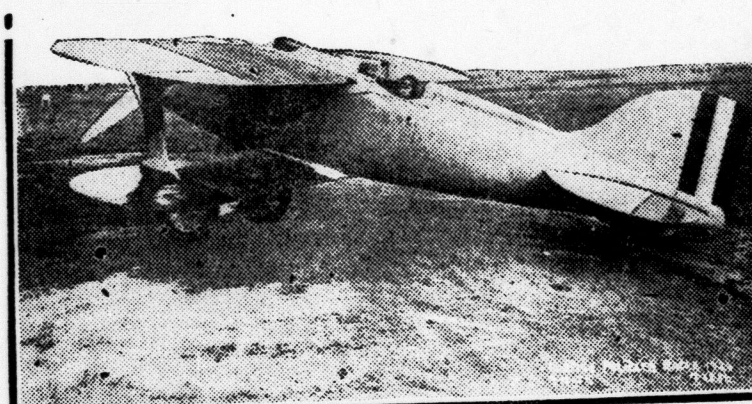

Adrian Paulen, champion quarter-mile sprinter of Holland, who has come to America, hoping to win more laurels.

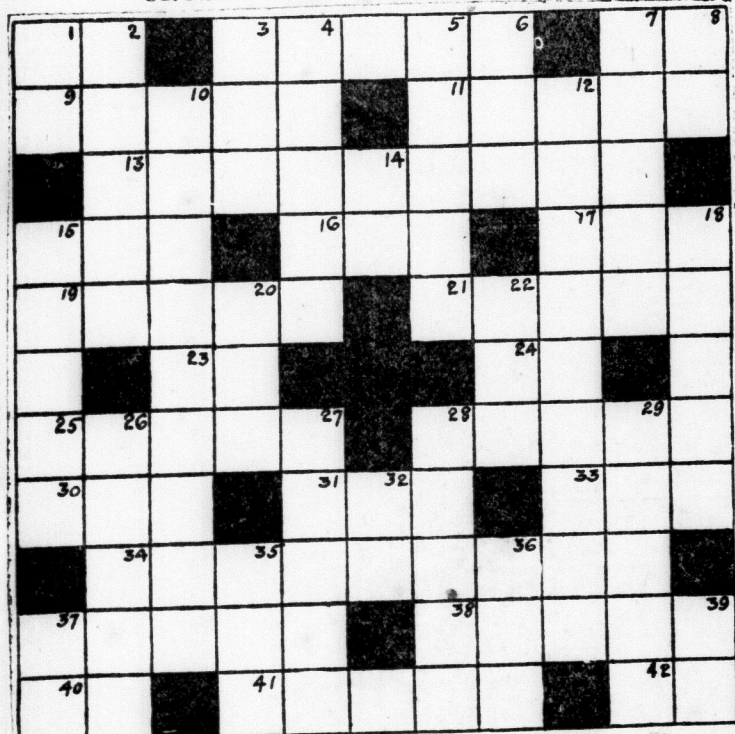


One of the twin Curtiss racers built for the United States government, which will be entered in the Pulitzer race, at Long island. Britain has entered two fliers.

NEW X-RAY APPARATUS.

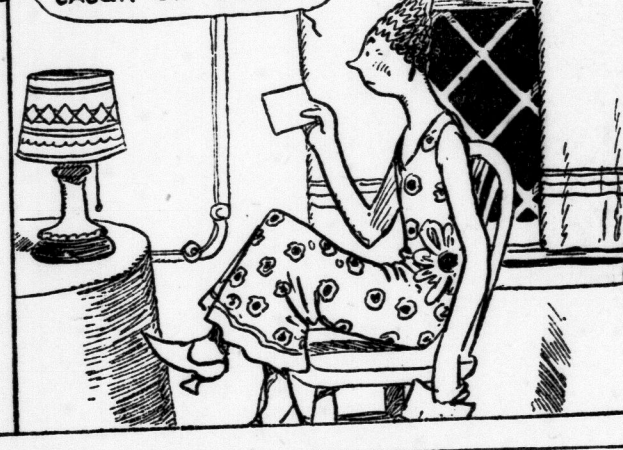
