NEW YORK, Sept. 14.—The Board of Health officially announced five deaths from the investigation of the physicians con-nected with the department. Professor Her-man Biggs, who is in charge of the division man Biggs, who is in charge of the division of Pathology and Bacteriology of the Health Department, has been at work making a bacteriological examination of the intestinal fluids taken from the bodies of these suspected cases. Prof. Biggs reported to the Health Department this afternoon the result of his examination, and announced unhesitatingly that they were Asiatic cholers beyond any doubt. Medical Commissioner of the Health Board Dr. Bryant said today: "I do not think that the disease will become epidemic." This, he says, is almost assured from the fact that no suspicious cases have occurred since yesterday. "There seems to be but little danger," said he, "so far, and the public need not be alarmed.
