The aborigines of America were probably the descendants of Noah, that is, America was first peopled by the sons of Noah, before the division of the globe. The fons of Noah are faid to have wandered over the earth. We read in the 25th verse of the 10th chapter of Genefis, of Peleg, that "in his days was the earth divided." The Hebrew word Peleg fignifies a division.--- It is a strong argument in favor of the division of the globe being a fact of great notoriety, that a man of eminence obtained his name from the circumstance. the Timæus of Plato it appears, that the Greeks had some idea of this event.* If we look at a map of the world, we shall think it highly probable, that the West India Islands have been separated

Plato in his Timæus says, it was reported there was formerly an island in the Atlantic, beyond the Pillars of Harcules, greater than Africa and Asia. He says that in a vast earthquake the earth opened, and swallowed up its warlike inhabitants, and the island itself was sunk in an enormous whirlpool.
