



## Bulletin of the Archconfraternity

I. Affiliation. — We are happy to be able, each month, to register some new parish in the Archconfraternity. This time it is the parish of St. Raphael at Williamstown, Mass., in the diocese of Springfield. The affiliation was effected on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July.

II. Indulgences of the Archconfraternity. — We publish the Indulgences that may be gained by the members of the Archconfraternity of St. Anne de Beaupré. Those who are interested in it will observe that by entering this society of prayers they have opened to themselves an extremely rich source of spiritual favors.

### INDULGENCES OF THE ARCHCONFRATERNITY

#### I. Remarks

1. All the Indulgences, plenary or partial, set forth below, may be applied to the souls in Purgatory.

2. Confession may be made and communion received, when necessary, on the previous day and in any church whatever. (Decree of 6<sup>th</sup> October 1870.)

3. The faithful who are in the habit of confessing their sins once a week may gain all the Indulgences, except that of the Jubilee, without repeating the confession. (Decree of 6<sup>th</sup> December 1863.)

4. For the faithful who are afflicted with habitual infirmities or chronic diseases, and who are prevented from going out by permanent physical disability, their respective confessors may change their visit to the church and the communion, -- but not confession -- for other pious works. Persons living in communities are excepted from this concession. (18<sup>th</sup> September 1862.)

5. If a feast is transferred for its celebration, the Indulgence to that feast is also transferred. (9<sup>th</sup> August 1862.)
