MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS

LISBON, March 31, 1958.

AMBASSADOR:

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of Your Excellency's Note No. 19, received by this Ministry on March 5 of this year, relating to the alteration of paragraph 7 of the Annex of the Agreement between the Government of Portugal and the Government of Canada on air services between the Portuguese and Canadian territories signed in Lisbon on April 25, 1947,\* the contents of which is as follows in Portuguese:

"I have the honour ..... Your Excellency's Note."

2. I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the Portuguese Government agrees to the proposals mentioned in Your Excellency's Note and shall consider that Note and this present reply as having constituted an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter.
