

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED MEXICAN STATES
REGARDING MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AND
CO-OPERATION
BETWEEN THEIR CUSTOMS ADMINISTRATIONS



The Government of Canada and the Government of
the United Mexican States,

CONSIDERING that offences against customs laws
are prejudicial to the economic, fiscal, social and
cultural interests of, as well as detrimental to the
legitimate interests of trade, industry and commerce
within their respective countries,

CONSIDERING the importance of the accurate
assessment of duties and taxes imposed on imported or
exported goods,

CONVINCED that greater co-operation between
their Customs Administrations can make their actions more
effective,

HAVE AGREED as follows:

ARTICLE I

Definitions

For the purpose of this Agreement,

- a) "Customs Administration" means, in
Canada, the Department of National
