Recently, Minister Habibie headed negotiations for the purchase of 32 three to ten year old Boeing-737 jets from Lufthansa. The jets will be offered to all domestic passenger airlines. The scheduled airlines also recently have placed an order for 20 F-100 airplanes for which IPTN is producing an offset order of airplane components.

 Imports of airplanes reached US\$ 306.3 million in 1991 and US\$ 98.3 million in 1992 Imports of airplanes have varied considerably since orders tend to be unevenly spaced but in large denominations. Imports of parts and components for helicopters are quite substantial, accounting for US\$ 406.3 million in 1990 out of a total market value of US\$ 444.7 million. Because IPTN must import many of the components it uses in the helicopters it produces, IPTN is the primary buyer of all helicopter parts and components.
