VISIT BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS

TO STANFORD, CALIFORNIA

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, will participate along with U.S. Secretary of State George Shultz and Mexican Secretary of External Relations Bernardo Sepulveda Amor in celebrations May 14 in honour of the 100th anniversary of the establishment of Stanford University.

The three Foreign Ministers will address Stanford University alumni and invited guests on the theme of North America's relations with the Pacific. This is in recognition of Stanford University's relationship with California's Silicon Valley and its corresponding prominent role in technological and economic links with Asia. Stanford University also has a developing Canadian Studies programme.

Mr. Clark will take the opportunity to hold trilateral and bilateral discussions with Mr. Shultz and Mr. Sepulveda.
