SOFATI LTÉE OF MONTREAL SELLS TO CAMEROON WITH FINANCING FOR THE BUYER FROM THE EXPORT DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The Honourable Pat Carney, Minister for International Trade, today announced that Sofati Ltée of Montreal has been awarded a major contract for the turnkey construction of six technical schools in Cameroon. The Export Development Corporation (EDC) is providing financing support of up to 77,990,000 ECU (European Currency Unit) or the equivalent of Cdn\$ 109,835,038 for the buyer.

Financing will be provided in the form of an allocation under a US\$ 100-million multi-currency line of credit between EDC and the Republic of Cameroon, signed in November 1986.

The schools will be built in Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Kumba, Sangmelima and Yaounde, and each will have various buildings for housing, classrooms, administration and other uses.

The borrower is the Republic of Cameroon represented by its Minister of Plan and Land Management, and the buyer is the Republic of Cameroon represented by its Deputy Minister to the Presidency in charge of Computer Technology and Public Markets.
