## APPOINTMENT OF CANADIANS FOR CANADA-U.S. DISPUTE SETTLEMENT

### PANELS ANNOUNCED

International Trade Minister John C. Crosbie and Finance Minister Michael H. Wilson today announced the appointment of a roster of Canadians to serve as panelists for the binational dispute settlement mechanisms established under Chapter 19 of the Free Trade Agreement. This chapter provides for binding binational panel dispute settlement in anti-dumping and countervail duty cases.

The two Ministers also announced the appointment of a roster of five retired judges from which members will be selected to serve on extraordinary challenge committees established under the Canada-U.S. Free Trade Agreement.
