(D) Other Allowances

- (i) Outfit allowance for officers of \$150 on appointment.
- (ii) Outfit allowance for warrant officers, class I of \$100 on appointment.
- (iii) Transport and travelling allowances when travelling on duty.
- (iv) Transport and travelling allowances to their residence prior to enlistment, when discharged.
- (v) Civilian clothing allowance on discharge of \$35. If service less than six months, \$27 in winter and \$17 in summer.
- (vi) Rehabilitation grant of thirty days' pay and dependents' allowance of 183 days' service completed.
- 2. The Canadian Women's Army Corps receives pay at two-thirds the rates for officers and other ranks of the army. They receive no additional pay. No dependents' allowance is paid on their behalf, and any dependents' allowance which they were receiving prior to enlistment is stopped when they become members of the C.W.A.C.
