NOTES ON THE EXPENDITURE REDUCTIONS

The government's expenditure planning cycle for the fiscal year 1976-77 began early in 1975. Departmental expenditure proposals were received in March and following analysis, the Treasury Board developed their first recommendations on expenditures which were approved by Cabinet in July. By November because of revisions in forecasts to statutory or other highly committed programs, the total requirement was considered to be too great by about \$1.5 billion. A review was begun culminating in the reductions listed below.
