That for the first year has been formulated after careful consideration of the replies received from interested Departments. It will be seen that no change has been made from the existing time-table in the case of any strictly B.A. course. At the same time the existing second year B.A., -B.Sc. time-table is submitted for your consideration. No laboratory hours or strictly Honours Courses have been included therein, and certain courses in which changes are contemplated have been with-held. Two points are worthy of attention: (1). The lack of availability of options, and (2). the difficulties encountered by B.A. students who do not take their science option by the end of their second year. We would be glad to receive a reply of approval or criticism with respect to our first year formulation within a week.
