\$10 each, \$30 added: mile heats. Three years old. 8 at 4lb; four years old, 9st 2 lb; five and upwards, 9st 8 lb.

1. Mr. Skinner's b h "Forward" aged.
2. Mr. Blumpe's d h "Maksi," aged.
3. Mr. Francis' c m "Fanny," 5; Red and Green.
4. Mr. Dupree's c h "Selleck," aged; Blue and Pink.

II—VICTORIA HANDICAP. 1st HEAT, 2; 2d HEAT, 2 30.

\$60 each, with \$100 added: mile heats; the second horse to save his stakes.

1. Mr. Dupree's g h "Volunteer," 8st 9lb: straw and blue stripe jacket and cap.
2. Captain Stuart's g h "Grey Arrow," 9st 2lb: blue jacket and cap.
3. Mr. Roberts' c h "Silvertail," 10st 6 lb: blue jacket and scarlet cap.

III—INNKEEPER'S PLATE. 1st HEAT 3; 2d HEAT, 3 30.

\$15 each, \$50 added; mile heats best three in five, weight for age. Winners of stakes of the value of \$100, 7lb extra, second horse to save his stakes.

2. Mr. Parker's b h "Moustache," aged; blue and orange.
3. Captain Stewart's c h "Pet," 5 years; blue jacket and cap.

IV.—MATCH. 4 O'CLOCK.

\$100 aside. Mr. Howard's "Black John," against Mr. Phillips' "Soda Water." Weight, 10 at 5 lb; one mile. "Soda Water" Orange and Blue. "Black John" Black Jacket, Red Garter and Black Cap.
