

10 and B. Lee, to have been fully and satisfactorily proved before them—and  
11 it shall be lawful for the said Commissioners to make and declare such  
12 dividends as they shall from time to time judge proper—always dividing  
13 upon the total amount of the losses so certified to have been satisfactorily  
14 proved, to every sufferer his rateable proportion of the monies so to be di-  
15 vided—and it shall be lawful for the said Commissioners to pay over the  
16 dividends to the said sufferers, or to their order, or to the legal repre-  
17 sentatives of such of them as may be deceased at the time of such divi-  
18 dend declared, and to retain therefrom, in full satisfaction of their costs,  
19 fees and expenses per cent on all sums paid over by  
20 them.

1 VII. *And be it further enacted,* That it shall be the duty of the Commissioners  
2 hereby appointed to account with the Comptroller for the execution of the  
3 trusts hereby confided to them.
