These cars are of the latest model and the equal in comfort and efficiency to those operated in any of the great American cities.

The P-A-Y-E car is recognized as a permanent feature of street railway operation in large communities, but in order that it may give the maximum of service some co-operation on the part of the public is required.

We therefore respectfully request passengers to have their fares ready when they step aboard, to ask for transfers as they pay their fares, and if for any reason there is to be delay in getting change or for other reasons, to stand aside on the back platform and not block the way for others who are ready to step inside.
