TRY HOWE ABUSES FIRST.
Robert Bickerdike, M.P., is making a great fuss over the British embargo. He has almost gone the length of issuing an ultimatum to Great Britain demanding under threat of secession of Canada from the empire the removal of restrictions on the Canadian cattle trade.
It is possible to admit Mr. Bickerdike's good faith in the campaign he has entered upon without endorsing the vigor of his language. But does it not occur to Mr. Bickerdike that the embargo on Canadian cattle is of very slight concern to Canada generally, compared with other questions which, as a member of parliament, he has had to deal with? Mr. Bickerdike has a seat in parliament and he has shown within the past two weeks that he has a voice which he can exercise to good purpose. Sad to relate this voice was still when the public treasury was being robbed to enrich members of parliament. Mr. Bickerdike among the rest, when scandalous transactions were brought before the house, when the sacred doctrine of provincial rights was assailed and when capital sought legislative warrant for inflicting all kinds of monopoly on the people.
These are a few of the many ineffectual in which Mr. Bickerdike ineffectually acquiesces in the Dominion parliament. He was dumb as an oyster when the moment of the cattle embargo was reached. A voice is heard in loud protest against the action of the British government. What a pity that Mr. Bickerdike could not have kept an appreciation of the value of the government of this country as he has of the government of Britain! A few courageous words spoken to correct abuses of home origin would work greater good than all the denunciation Mr. Bickerdike may indulge in at the expense of the mother country.

SCANDINAVIA PARTS IN PEACE.
Altho it was scarcely credible that Norway and Sweden would carry strained relations to the point of rupture, or in that event would be allowed to enter upon what could only be termed a fratricidal war, there will be general relief and satisfaction that an agreement has been reached by the national representatives themselves. What the actual terms of dissolution are is of comparatively minor importance. Matters which at such a moment loom very large in the minds of delegates affected by the atmosphere inseparable from so radical a revolution, the restoration of tranquillity and the growth of better feeling soon lose their apparent importance and are in time superseded. The great fact is that the two nations have, under circumstances provocative of somewhat dangerous tempers on both sides, arranged to part in peace, and to trust the future to bring with it a more sympathetic understanding.
Notwithstanding some hot-headed talk on the part of a section of the Swedish public, both countries deserve credit for their conduct during the crisis. But special praise is due to the restors, under a trial peculiarly painful and galling, has acted with infinite generosity and nobleness. If a ruler so just and capable found it impossible to reconcile the conflicting claims of the two kindred and proud peoples, of whom he was the constitutional head, he would have been placed to the statement of both nations that a dual monarchy was absolutely impossible. That being so, and coercion on the part of Sweden being, if not impossible, at least ruinous and impolitic in the highest degree, the wiser course was clearly to accept the inevitable.
Another circumstance not without general significance was the example of solidarity and fraternity set by the element in both countries. A straight declaration was made by the workingmen on behalf of peace, and this is symptomatic of a sentiment which appears to be daily growing stronger in the ranks of international labor. It is emphatically a movement which, if it develops and strengthens, must lead to remarkable and world-wide results. Not only will it have a far-reaching bearing on peace relations, but it will tend to counteract the rising spirit of commercial rivalry which many observers foretell to be the real danger in the path of universal peace. It would be a wonderful consummation if out of the evolution of trade unionism should come the first practical step towards international union and world federation.

PROGRESS OF GLASGOW MUNICIPALITY.
From the accounts of the City of Glasgow municipal telephone system for the year to May 31 last, which have just been issued, it is evident the undertaking is both successful and progressing. After paying all working expenses, efficiently maintaining the whole plant, paying interest on loans and transferring \$50,000 to the sinking fund account, there remained a surplus of \$7500 to be carried to the general depreciation fund, now standing at upwards of \$28,000. Nearly 1000 new subscribers were added during the past year, and more than that number of new stations are in operation.
