

Recommendations for legislation were submitted as follows:-"That appropriate provision be made for punishment of any attempt, by intimidation, threats, inducements, or otherwise, to influence the testimony of any witness before the commission or to deter him from testifying; as also for punishment of misbehavior, disorderly corduct, or contumacy, in or about any proceeding before the commission.
