**HON. H. S. BELAND AT UNVEILING IN UNITED STATES**  
Ottawa, Oct. 12.—(Canadian Press)—Hon. H. S. Beland, minister of health, soldiers' civil re-establishment, is representing Canada at the unveiling of a statue to the late Lord Byrd, in New York and to Edmund Burke in Washington, this week. The statues have been erected by the Sulgrave Institute, an organization for promoting better relations between Great Britain and the United States. Dr. Beland spoke at a banquet in New York on Tuesday. In the name of Canada, he placed a wreath on the unknown soldier's grave at Arlington. Premier King was invited to be present and represent Canada, but was unable to do so.
