A London auctioneer has just dispersed, at small prices, a collection of rare and extremely valuable books and MSS relating to the early history of the American continent. Among them were the original private records of the French Commanders in Chief in Canada during the Old Seven Years' War, from 1755 to 1760. These sold for \$320

There was also a long original letter, signed by Don Diego Columbus, and addressed to Charles V., not dated, but evidently written in 1519; another letter to Charles V., from Hornado Cortes, with signature, and very in teresting; a letter of Sir Francis Drake to the Earl of Essex; a letter of Di-go de Almagro to Charles V., dated in Peru, January, 1535; the original autograph MS of rns's ode on the American War; and long and beautiful antograph letter of President Washington to the Rev. M. Boucher, of Annapolis, respecting, the education of his step-son. This last brought \$125; the Cortes
