Any even numbered section of Domin-ion Lands in Manitoba or the Nerthwest Provinces, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less.

Application for homestead entry must be made in person by the applicant at the office of the local Agent or Sub-Agent,

Entry by proxy may, however, be made om certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother, or sister of an intending homesteader. An application for entry or inspection made personally at any Sub-Agent's office

an application for entry or inspection made personally at any. Sub-Agent by the Sub-Agent, at the expense of the applicant, and if the land applied for is vacant on receipt of the telegram such application is to have priority and the land will be held until the necessary papers to complete the transaction are received by mail. In case of "personation" the entry will be summarily cancelled and the applicant will forfeit all priority of claim.

An application for inspection must be made in person. The applicant must be eligible for homestead entry, and only one application for inspection will be received from an individual until that application has been disposed of.

A homesteader whose entry is in good standing and not liable to cancellation, may, subject to approval of Department, relinquish it in favor of father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister, if eligible, but to no one else, on filing declaration of abandonment.

Where an entry is summarily cancelled.

iowing plans:

(1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTHWEST MINING REGULATIONS.

COAL.—Coal mining rights may be
leased for a period of twenty-one years at
an annual rental of \$1 per acre. Not
more than \$2560 acres shall be leased to
one individual or company. A royalty
at the rate of five cents per ton shall be
collected on the merchantable coal mined.

QUARTZ.—A person eighteen years of
age, or over, having discovered mineral in
place, may locate a claim 1,500 x 1,500
feet.

place, may locate a claim 1,500 x 1,500 feet.

The fee for recording a claim is \$5.
At least \$100 must be expended on the claim each year or paid to the mining recorder in lieu thereof. When \$500 has been expended or paid, the locator may upon having a survey made, and upon complying with other requirements, purchase the land at \$1 per acre.

The patent provides for the payment of a royalty of \$2\cdot per cent_ on the sales. Placer mining claims generally are 100 feet square; entry fee \$5, renewable yearly.

An applicant may obtain two leases to reet square; entry tee 50, renewable yearly.

An applicant may obtain two leases to dredge for gold of five miles each for a term of twenty years, renewable at the discretion of the Minister of the Interior.

The lesses shall have a dredge in operation within one season from the date of the lease for each five miles. Rental 310 per annum for each mile of river lessed. Royalty at the rate of 2½ per cent. collected on the output after it exceeds 310,000.
