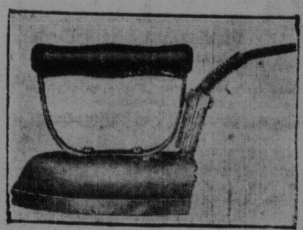

2,000 Delegates Expected at Great International Gathering at Toronto Oct. 28-31-- Canada's Share in It.
