imposed by this act in each of the said districts, with power to dismiss from time to time such Receiver, to appoint another in his stead, when so dismissed, or in case of death or resignation; and the said Receiver so appointed, shall keep an exact. and particular account, of all such monies as shall: be received by him by virtue of and under the authority of this Act, and shall apply the same quarterly in discharge of the salaries of the said Police Magistrates, Clerks, Peace Officers, Messengers and other persons by the said Magistrates employed, as well as other expences incurred in the said Offices, which he may be directed to pay by order of either of the Police Magistrates and which order shall specify the object for which such expence shall have been incurred.

. VIII. Provided always, and be it further enacted, by the authority aforesaid, that such Receiver, shall every six months and oftener if required, deliver to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person having the administration of the Government of this Province for the time being, a full and particular account of all monies by him received and paid as aforesaid, with vouchers for the same; which account shall be verified upon oath before one of the Judges of his Majesty's Court of King's Bench of the district in which he shall reside, and such Receiver for his care and pains in the execution of such Office, shall and may retain for his own use out of the monies by him received as aforesaid, such sum not exceeding five pounds per centum, as the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person having the administration of the Government for the time being in this Province, shall direct and appoint, provid-
