wary and unsuspicious, and thoughtful womanhood can have no higher aim or object in life than to do all in their power to protect and guide the helpless and to form the tastes and inclinations of the young aright, so as to keep their minds pure and spotless, while being intelligent and well-informed, and to fit them to take their places in the world, when the time shall arrive for it, as young men and women, strong, intelligent, pure, and self-reliant.
