Table XX. is a statement of the number of churches belonging to the several denominations, the higher class of educational institutions, penitentiaries and gaols, with the number of inmates thereof on 4th April, 1881.

The addendum Table A. is a statement of the component parts of the several classes of occupations given at the end of the Table of Occupations (XIV.,) from which it is abstracted.

Two slight errors occurred in Vol. 1, by which the total number of widowed is erroneously increased by 142, and the number of children and unmarried are unduly diminished by that number.

This volume is furnished with two indexes of subjects; one in numerical, the other in alphabetical order. There is also an alphabetical table of subjects.

The index of sub-districts to the first volume is so framed as to serve for all, in the manner explained in the introduction to that volume.

It is proposed that a further report shall be issued, in which comparisons, ratios, proportions and deductions will b discussed; and such few errors as have been discovered will be rectified.
