An Act respecting the Qualification of Municipal Officers who are ex-officio Justices of the Peace.

WHEREAS, by the Act respecting Municipal Institutions in Upper Preamble. V Canada, it is provided that certain Officers of Municipal Councils shall be ex-officio Justices of the Peace for the County or united Counties in which their respective municipalities lie; and whereas it is necessary 5 and desirable to require that such persons so exercising the functions of Justices of the Peace should have the same qualifications as those appointed by the Governor under the Great Seal of the Province; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—
