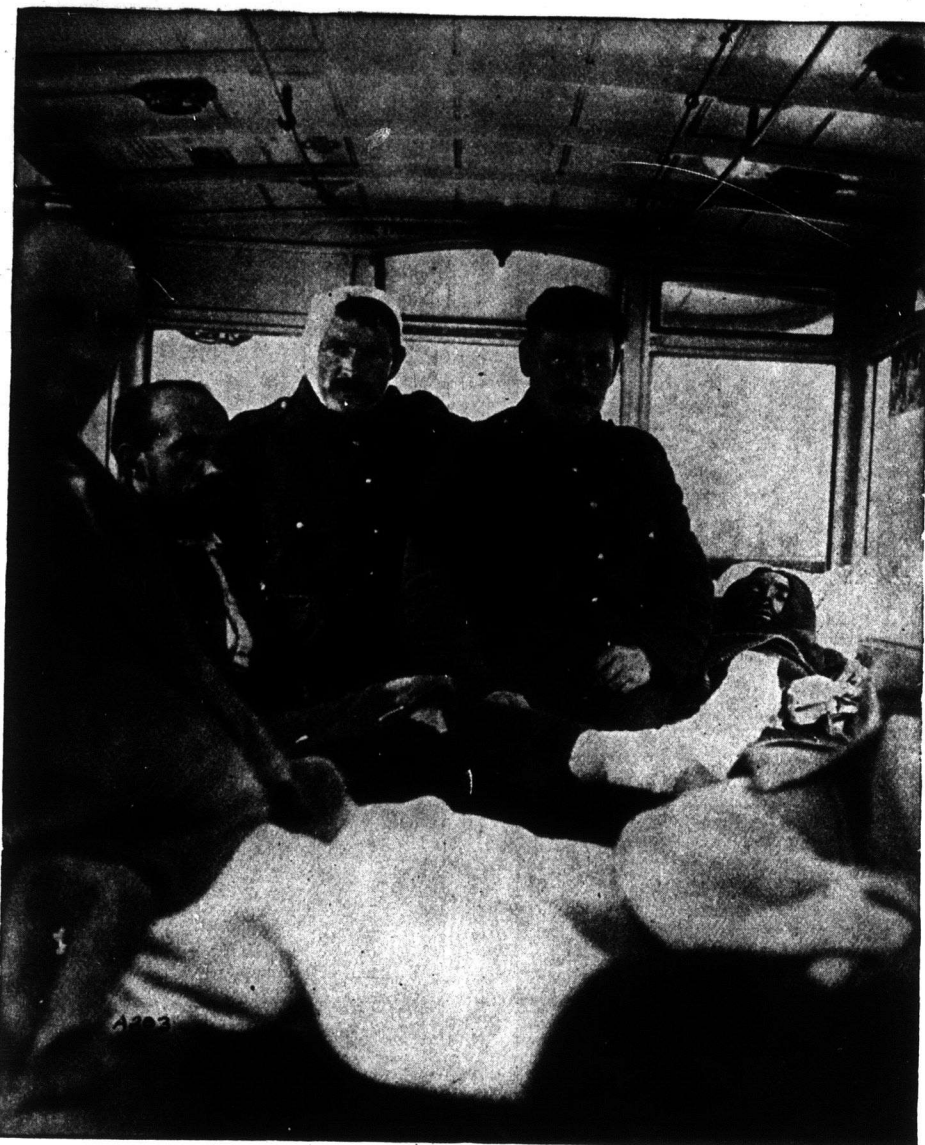




Wounded British Sailors in a London Motor Bus in Belgium en route to the nearest Hospital.



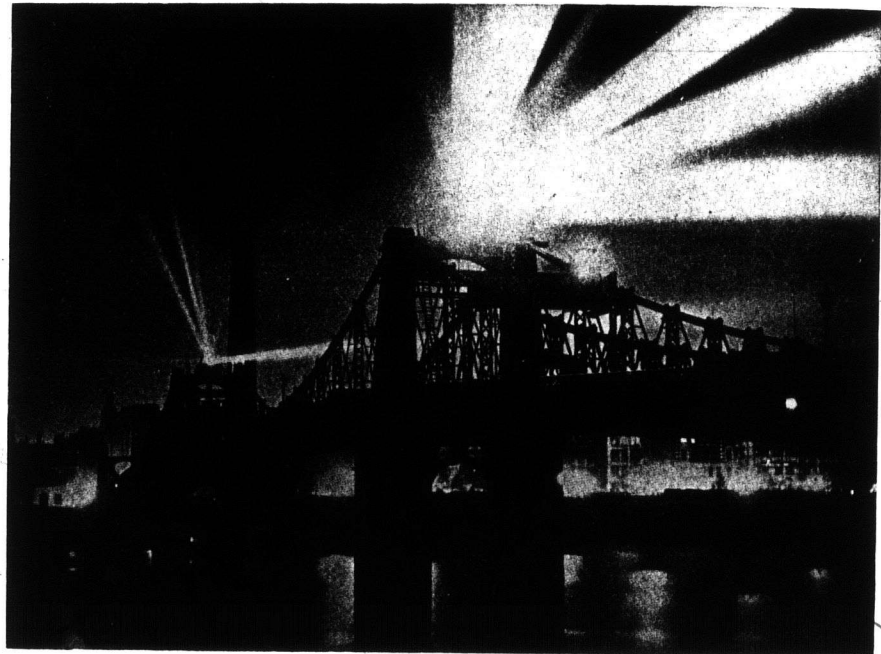

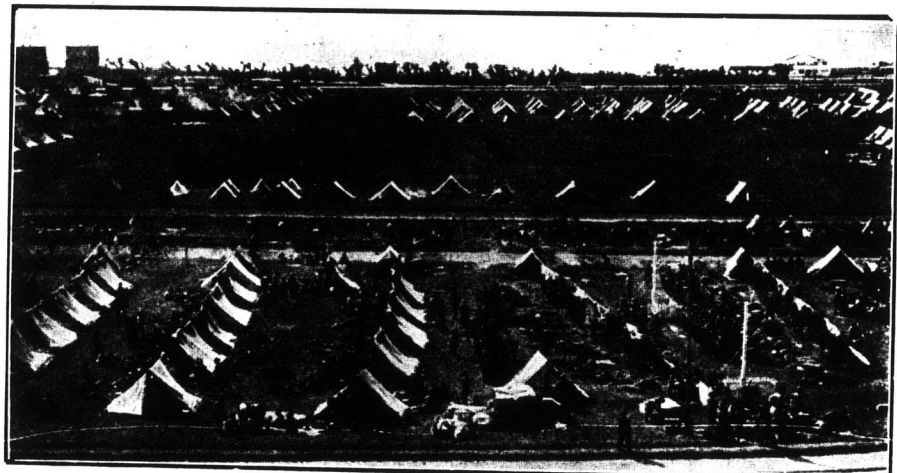
