If you could improve the SUB in any way, what would you do?



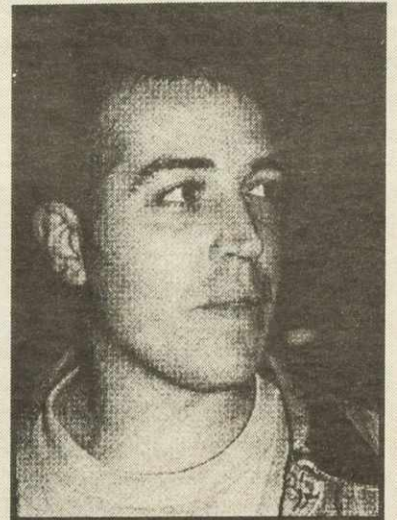
I wish the Grawood would serve better food, faster.
